

2nd Grade Grading Symbols

Here are the common grading symbols that you will see on work that comes home in your child's Monday folder.

One important thing to know is that **only assessments are graded for a grade** that goes into our grade books. Other assignments may be "checked" or "marked" for wrong answers but if they were done as class work, group work, or just practice they will not be graded as an assessment.

P – This was done for **practice**.

T – This was done **together** as a class. Individual items may not have been "checked" as your child should have the correct answers since we did it together.

Assessments

An assessment is something that your child does independently without help. It shows your child's understanding of a particular standard or standards. Assessments may be paper or they may be teacher observation of a task. Assessments are graded using the Wake County levels (see below).

4	Student consistently demonstrates an in-depth knowledge of the standards, concepts and skills taught.
3	Student consistently demonstrates an understanding of the standards, concepts and skills taught.
2	Student is approaching an understanding of the standards, concepts and skills taught.
1	Student does not yet demonstrate understanding of the standards, concepts and skills taught.
